Ukraine. We have moved straight from one crisis to another, but we are so thankful to God for the way Slovene brothers and sisters are uniting to Care, Connect, and Share. Through Slovenia's global connections with Pentecostal networks and our relationships with missionaries, we can directly support the refugees on the Hungarian / Ukraine, and Polish / Ukraine borders. Our churches and workers are directly helping the workers. Norbert our Hungarian colleague shares that, people are facing very difficult situations, struggling to support family members, power and food supplies are unreliable etc. Norbert shares that he is connecting with human trafficking agencies and working to get orphans out. Boris in Urša – Podgorica, Montenegro. Working in one of the least reached countries of the world, for the Gospel, Montenegro has many challenges. Thanks to God's grace and provision Boris and Urša were able recently to obtain their own home, which is a big blessing when working in fulltime ministry. Urša is a native Slovene, Boris is Serbian by birth, they have followed the Lord's leading to live and serve in Podgorica, the capital of Montenegro, working alongside Jovica who is pastoring the first Evangelical church in the nation.

Boris and Urša lead worship in the local church, as part of this work Boris has written several worship songs, some of which are sung in the neighboring country of Croatia as well as the local church. We are hoping to help Boris record some worship in the future. **Please pray** for Boris and Urša, their two children, their worship leading, and the growth of the kingdom in Montenegro.

Pastor Sašo in Renata – Kumanovo, Macedonia. The church in Slovenia has had a unique privilege to journey together with Sašo and Renata for over two decades. It was on our early mission trip of 2004, where we collected funds in Slovenia to pay for the architects cost to design the church. In 2010 during one of our 9 mission trips, we able to help clean the building and prepare for opening the 1st floor for services. Thanks to the Lord for his gracious support, the bottom floor, which will be used as the sanctuary is nearly ready and in 2022 will be open for services. Macedonia has had a very rough time with the Covid, Kumanovo church has lost three members to the Virus. In Slovenia we were privileged to partner with Sašo to help them produce his book for Church History, now we are seeking to raise 2500€ to produce this book in English and Slovene, Lord willing.

Please pray for Sašo in Renata, their family as they rebuild believers after the Covid-19 pandemic, pray for the church building project to finish the final task and for Sašo and Renata's work among the churches in Macedonia.
