### Boris & Urša – Podgorica, Montenegro.

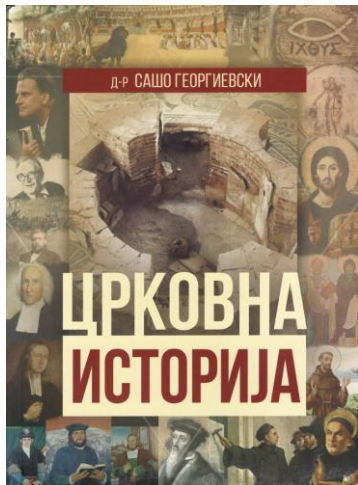

We are very much looking forward to how the Lord will lead this music project and the results that will be achieved. Boris already has one of his songs sung in the Croatian church. Over the summer pastor Jovica has taken a mini sabbatical after over 25 years of ministry and will return to Novi Sad for three months. This gives an opportunity for Boris and Urša to provide leadership for the church during this time.
